**Background:** I have been involved in organized hockey for the past 40 years at most levels. I grew up in the south end of Ottawa playing competitive hockey from Minor Atom through to Major Midget. I then went on to play Tier II, NCAA, A.H.L. and N.H.L. I have been involved within KMHA for the past 5 years as an on ice helper, assistant coach and for the previous 2 seasons as a head coach.

**Philosophy:** My philosophy is pretty simple; have fun, teach the fundamentals, increase self-confidence, provide leadership and direction for the group. Areas to be emphasized this season; skating, individual skills/tactics, team play/tactics, passing, play with and without the puck, focus, work ethic, discipline, respect, team commitment and conditioning all within a team first approach.

**Commitment:** Player and family commitment is very important to the success of this program. Depending on the schedule, expect to be at the rink between 3-6 times per week. Obviously family and school are everyone's top priorities but it is expected that this team's hockey commitments take priority over all other sports and activities throughout the season. The financial commitment from each family will require 3 checks of \$500 - \$600 staggered throughout the year. Parents will be asked to spearhead fundraising projects and find sponsorship money to help balance the team budget.

Also, please note it will be a coach's decision which positions players start the season at once I have selected the team.
