



Welcome to the 2016-2017 Major Midget B hockey season!

My name is Andy Brothers, Head Coach, and I want to take this opportunity to introduce myself to those who do not know me as well, give you an idea of what the upcoming season will entail.

I have been involved with the sport in one way or another for 30 years (as a player and a coach). I have been a part of KMHA for the past 5 years as either an Assistant Coach or Head Coach.

My coaching philosophy is that focus, teamwork and discipline will be vehicles that will allow us to enjoy success. I will be looking for players who are coachable, focused and willing to learn.

The team will be on the ice 2 – 4 times per week (includes games and practices). We might potentially do some off ice workouts too (yet to be determined). In addition to the time commitment, the financial commitment will be approximately \$1500-\$2000 per player (this is above the KMHA player registration).

The team will be attending 4 or 5 tournaments this season (yet to be determined where). The plan is to have 2 or 3 away tournaments and 1 or 2 local. Once they have been selected, I will provide and update.

The tryouts will likely be the 2nd week of September (dates and times will be posted to KMHA website). These sessions will be a combination of some skills sessions, intra-squad games and exhibition games. The team will be made of 17 (or 18) players who show a high level of compete, discipline and team play.
