Registration Update

KMHA is now accepting applications for referees and timekeepers for the 2017/2018 season. Deadline to apply is July 15th, 2017. All applicants will have to pass a multiple choice rule quiz, with a score of 75%. Those who are successful on the quiz will move on to the interview and skating test.

A prospective official should register as a new referee if he/she is:

- A first year official (someone who has never refereed before)
- An official who was certificated last year, but worked in another branch, district or association.
- An official who previously refereed in Kanata, but has been inactive in Kanata, and does NOT have the permission of the RIC to register as a returning official.
- Is a minimum of 14 years of age.
