CODE OF CONDUCT FOR TEAM OFFICIALS (Managers, trainers, staff)

- Respect and adhere to the ideals, policies, and rules determined by KMHA and my team.
- Refrain from comments or behaviors, which are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist or behavior, which constitutes harassment or abuse or bullying.
- Respect the decisions of the Coaches, whether at practice, special events, or during a game.
- Respect all participants and recognize that you are in a position of trust and power, and will do nothing to take advantage of or abuse it.
- Communicate concerns and attempt to resolve conflicts directly with the coaching staff before communicating with KMHA officials.
- Do your best to be a competent team official, well prepared and adequately skilled and will obtain training and certification as required by the KMHA.
- In the event of significant incidents, advise KMHA as soon as possible through proper channels.
